By focusing on these specific issues, the workshop prepares professionals to optimize their printing operations for knitted substrates and achieve consistent, high-quality results in commercial production settings.



Upon completion of this workshop, participants will be able to:

- Understand the unique characteristics of knitted fabrics that impact printing processes
- Select appropriate printing methods for different knit constructions and fiber compositions
- Troubleshoot common printing defects specific to knitted substrates
- Optimize pre-treatment, printing, and post-treatment processes for knit fabrics
- Implement quality control measures for knit fabric printing operations
- Calculate production costs and efficiency metrics for knit printing processes
